WHY Apply for the Accelerated BA/MA Program?

Advanced undergrads can take courses at the graduate level while earning their BA

Up to nine credits can be counted toward both the BA and the MA

WHO should apply?

Sophomores and juniors who want to start the program as seniors

Students with a minimum GPA of 3.0 overall and 3.5 in English

English majors with 60 credits overall, at least 9 of them in English

When starting the program, students must have completed Engl 302 or 324
