## 4. myUMBC AI update - proposed next steps - Collier

We plan to roll it out before the spring semester. You will be able to opt in or opt out of the features. If you choose to opt in, there will be a small toggle. Disclaimer will be displayed to make sure they double-check with their adviser. For every answer the AI gives, there will be a place to rate the answer if it was helpful or not. If not, more options will show up and ask what was not helpful. All of this is to be making improvements.

## 5. Update on Quota implementation for Cloud Storage - Ally

25 GB Google and One Drive for staff and faculty. Students will get 5 GB of shared drives, set to a default of 20 GB on both platforms.

100 alumni people who are using the majority of the storage allocated for alumni. We must instruct graduating students to keep their storage under a specific limit. Google Photos are being removed from all UMBC accounts. Storage here counts towards your overall Google quota. If users have content in Google Photos, they still have access. They will receive communications this week from DoIT with resources to migrate photos to their personal Google account, device, or storage option.

We do not want staff and faculty to have limitations in their work. Please get back to DoIT if you notice this. We will take care of that.
