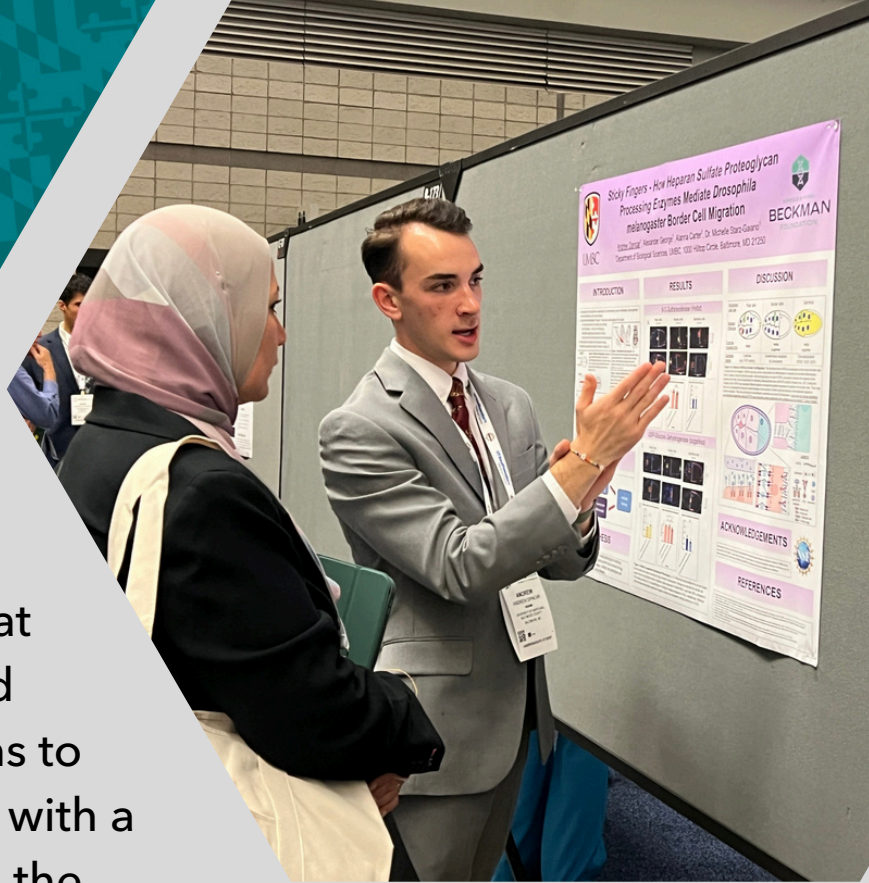

- ✓ Status as a second- or third- year student at UMBC
- ✓ Full-time enrollment status at UMBC

PROGRAM BENEFITS

- ✓ **\$18,200** stipend-based payments for scholars
- ✓ **\$2,800** funding for travel and conference participation
- ✓ Participation in a structured 14-month scholars program
- ✓ Pairing with a UMBC research mentor to complete an authentic research project
