Who is NAVAIR:

Naval Air Systems Command (NAVAIR) is the principal provider of aircraft, aircraft based weapons, and aircraft support for the Navy and Marine Corps. We procure, develop, test, and support all Navy and Marine Corps aircraft, the systems within those aircraft, and the weapons carried on those aircraft.

Overview of Events:

During the morning, participants will shadow an entry level employee and will experience a "day in the life" of a NAVAIR employee. Hosts may take participants on individual lab tours, introduce them to senior engineers/scientists, and expose them to day-to-day operations at Patuxent River. Following lunch, participants will go on group tours to various facilities, hangars, and state-of-the-art laboratory spaces to introduce participants to some of the technologies, aircraft and environments which NAVAIR deals with on a day to day basis.

Eligibility Requirements:

- **MUST be a U.S. Citizen**
- **Must be a FEMALE**, as we are targeting minority groups
- Must be currently enrolled in a degree-seeking program
- Must be able to provide your own transportation to/from Patuxent River
