After School Program Volunteer Tutor

Attend Refugee Youth Project's after school program each week as part of a team of dedicated UMBC volunteers. Here, you will work one-on-one or with small groups of refugee students to ensure their homework is accurate and complete. Assist these students in developing and improving their English language skills, study habits, and reading. Bond with students over art projects, board games, and soccer! Ultimately, make a difference by serving as a welcoming and supportive presence to these students!

- Mondays or Wednesdays 4:00pm–6:00pm
- Transportation is provided
- Orientation required

College JUMP (Journey Upward Mentoring Program) Volunteer Mentor

Serve as a mentor and guide to an 11th or 12th grade refugee student who plans to continue their education beyond high school. Meet with your mentee each week and guide him or her through the college exploration, application, and preparation process. Join your mentee for fun monthly events on various college campuses. Ultimately, empower this student to attain the skills and mindset to be successful in college!

- Must be a sophomore or above and have reliable transportation
- Timing determined by mentor and mentee
(2hrs/wk with mentee, plus monthly special events)
- Orientation and college access training required
